Professor Antonia Maioni earned a BA from Université Laval, an MA from Carleton University, and a PhD in political science from Northwestern University.

Having joined McGill University in 1994, professor Maioni is jointly appointed to the Department of Political Science and the Institute for Health and Social Policy. Her research focuses on healthcare reform and the Canadian political process.

She has held visiting appointments at the Minda de Gunzburg Center for European Studies at Harvard University, the North American Studies program at Duke University, and the Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies at the European University Institute.

Professor Maioni served for 10 years as the director of the McGill Institute for the Study of Canada, and is currently the dean of the Faculty of Arts. As a commentator for media such as CTV News and the Globe and Mail, she has regularly engaged audiences in thoughtful dialogues about public policy issues.

Through her administrative work, Dr. Léger contributes to enhancing service quality and accessibility for the population base of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) of Abitibi-Témiscamingue.
